一、活動資訊

We regret all the inconvenience this may cause to all of you who have registered to summit 2020.

Tanzania 4H Organization is cordially welcoming all 4H Organizations to send participants to third Global 4H Summit in Arusha, Tanzania. African region and Tanzania is proud to host the summit and warmly welcomes members, volunteers, professionals and board members to Tanzania.

World is changing incredibly fast, we feel that 4H is Inspiring youth for change. There are huge political, social, health, environmental and economical challenges that youth face today. If provided with skills and very good communication, life skills and entrepreneurial attitude, young people will be better equipped to

Dates: 7th-12th August 2023

First Global summit was hosted by Korea 4H in 2014. Global 4H Network was founded then and thereafter Canada 4-H hosted a wonderful second Global Summit in Ottawa, Canada. 4H Learns website was launched at the Ottawa summit. Now 4H'ers from 80 countries all over the world are welcome to Arusha, Tanzania to third Global 4H Summit. In Tanzania there is time allocated for regional meetings, on two days. (to be confirmed later). Aim is to discuss of the future of Global 4H Network and how to strengthen its organization and work.

Profile of participants

4H organizations are welcome to send their delegations up to 15 persons each. If having bigger delegation the organization should contact organizers. We expect all participants to be minimum 18 years old upon arrival to Tanzania. Delegates can be 4H members, professionals, volunteers or staff. Summit language is English! There is no interpretation available.

Arrival and visa arrangements

We advise international delegates to arrive by air to Kilimanjaro international airport. It is 60 km from Arusha. Organizers provide a transport to hotels and back to airport upon departure.

We advise all to obtain visas at the Embassy in their home country to avoid long queues at the immigration upon arrival. Online visa application available: look for more information at <https://eservices.immigration.go.tz/visa/>

Flights should be booked so that your delegation will be in Arusha either morning or afternoon of 7th August. If you arrive by land, you should arrive to bus depot in Arusha. If given arrival times for organizers, there will be pick up from bus depot as well. Summit shuttles are marked by summit logo. In addition there are volunteers who assist with any kind of questions at the airport.

Participants must obey the health regulations and carry certificate of given vaccinations with them.

Travel hints

There are several air companies flying via Kilimanjaro International airport. August is high season, so please do your booking early. You can save in flight costs significantly if doing booking in the beginning of the year 2023. Look also new options provided by Air Tanzania. It is going to open new route from Asia directly to Dar Es Salaam.

Getting to Arusha – Tanzania

As a premier tourism and event destination, national and international access to Arusha City is easy. Kilimanjaro International Airport (KIA) is located in the east of Kilimanjaro Region is a 45 minutes drive to Arusha City. There are Local and International flights almost every day which include, Precision air, Kenya Airways, Ethiopian Airline, KLM, Air France, Uganda Airline, Rwanda air, South African Airline & Qatar airways.

Health issues

We advise you to contact your medical clinic and check that you have got all necessary vaccinations. In addition malaria medication is obligatory.

Departure

Departures can be planned for 12th August morning or afternoon, if you depart directly after the summit. In case of using the opportunity to go for safari at Tarangire game park, please you are advised to book your flights on late night flights on 12th August, or morning 13th August.

Insurance

It is utmost important that each delegate has got a valid travel insurance, which covers also the transport to home country if in need of special assistance.

Registration

Early registration by March 15th will get a discount 10 %. Discount is granted in case the registration fees are paid to Tanzania 4H Organization Summit account by the end of March 2023.

Summit is expecting 500 or more delegates from all over the world from five continents.

Safari on 12th August

Early morning departure by coach to Tarangire game park. Safari is all inclusive, transport by safari company, refreshment on board, lunch, tour guide and park fees. Safari fee will be 400,- USD (to be confirmed)

Tanzania 4-H Organization works to encourage youth to participate in entrepreneurship activities by educating them on topics ranging from agriculture to technology to healthy living with learning by doing and earning by doing approaches.

We strive for our club members to learn practical skills, become active citizens and use critical thinking, conserve and learn about the environment, live healthy lives and grow up to become the leaders of tomorrow.

Kilimanjaro is one of the world's most accessible high summits, a beacon for visitors from around the world. Most climbers reach the crater rim with little more than a walking stick, proper clothing and determination. And those who reach Uhuru Point, the actual summit, or Gillman's Point on the lip of the crater, will have earned their climbing certificates.

And their memories.

About Kilimanjaro National Park

Size: 1668 sq km 641 sq miles).

Location: Northern Tanzania, near the town of Moshi.

Getting there

128 km (80 miles) from Arusha.

About one hour's drive from Kilimanjaro International airport.

About Arusha National Park

Size: 552 sq km 212 sq miles).

Location: Northern Tanzania, northeast of Arusha town..

The Serengeti is famed for its annual migration, when some six million hooves pound the open plains, as more than 200,000 zebra and 300,000 Thomson's gazelle join the wildebeest's trek for fresh grazing. Yet even when the migration is quiet, the Serengeti offers arguably the most scintillating game-viewing in Africa

About Serengeti

Size: 14,763 sq km (5,700 sq miles).

Location: 335km (208 miles) from Arusha, stretching north to Kenya and bordering Lake Victoria to the west.

Getting there

Scheduled and charter flights from Arusha, Lake Manyara and Mwanza.

Drive from Arusha, Lake Manyara, Tarangire or Ngorongoro Crater.

Arusha National Park is a multi-faceted jewel, often overlooked by safarigoers, despite offering the opportunity to explore a beguiling diversity of habitats within a few hours.

About Arusha National Park

Size: 552 sq km 212 sq miles).

Location: Northern Tanzania, northeast of Arusha town.

Getting there

An easy 40-minute drive from Arusha. Approximately 60 km (35 miles) from Kilimanjaro International Airport. The lakes, forest and Ngurdoto Crater can all be visited in the course of a half-day outing at the beginning or end of an extended northern safari.

Lake Manyara is a scenic gem, with a setting extolled by Ernest Hemingway as “the loveliest I had seen in Africa”. Stretching for 50km along the base of the rusty-gold 600-metre high Rift Valley escarpment, the compact game-viewing circuit through Manyara offers a virtual microcosm of the Tanzanian safari experience.

About Lake Manyara National Park

Size: 330 sq km (127 sq miles), of which up to 200 sq km (77 sq miles) is lake when water levels are high.

Location: In northern Tanzania. The entrance gate lies 1.5 hours (126km/80 miles) west of Arusha along a newly surfaced road, close to the ethnically diverse market town of Mto wa Mbu.

Getting there

By road, charter or scheduled flight from Arusha, en route to Serengeti and Ngorongoro Crater.

Ngorongoro conservation area covers over 5149 sq miles and one of the most spectacular sights you are ever likely to see while on safari lies in the Ngorongoro Crater. The crater is a microcosm of the East African savannah and a natural wonder unique in the world. Upon descent to the crater floor you are treated to a magical experience where herds of zebra rub shoulders with wildebeest, gazelle and buffalo. The crater provides a great chance of seeing some of Africa’s biggest bull elephants and many predators among a myriad of other animals.

Olduvai Gorge is famous for its fossil finds – about 150 species of prehistoric mammals including the Dr. Leakey’s discovery of 400 fragments of a skull. A small museum displays a number of copies of the finds. Olduvai gains its name from the Masai word for the wild sisal that is prolific here.
